## Clubs at Wraparound Care

We are very excited to advise that there will be some additional activities available after half term through our Wraparound Care (WAC) after school provision.

These will run after snack time has finished, and children will be asked if they would like to choose this as their first activity, they will have the opportunity to move on to other activities afterwards:

We are excited to advise that the range of clubs available at Wraparound Care (WAC) are continuing to increase and we can now offer:



### **Chess Club (for children in Y3-Y6)**

This will run on **Mondays**. Children need to already understand the rules of the game and how to play. They will have the opportunity to play against their peers supervised by keen staff chess players.

### **Homework Club (all age groups)**

Fridays and Mondays. A member of staff will be on hand to help the children understand the task, and they will have a quiet space to sit and complete the work. This will be helpful for children who find it hard to focus on homework at home, or if you have a hectic weekend and they may not have time to complete it on the weekend.



### **Needlework Club (Y4-Y6).**

This new club will start in December on Friday 5th. Available for pupils in Y4 upwards there will be a different focus each term including cross stitch, felting, embroidery and sewing.
