Dear Parents and Carers

Parent Survey

Thank you to everyone who completed the parent survey. Whilst the sample was only relatively small, we share a very similar perspective of the school and recognise the broad areas that were highlighted as areas for further development.

Strengths	Areas For Further Development
• Relationships and care • Teaching and Learning • SEND Provision • Enrichment Offer • Communication	• Behaviour • Curriculum Consistency • SEND consistency • Operational issues • Communication

A minority of parents (approximately 4 responses) raised concerns regarding behaviour, particularly around low-level disruption and the consistency with which expectations are applied, indicating that this can impact on pupils' learning experiences in some classes.

Communication, while generally positive, is identified in around 3 responses as an area requiring greater consistency and clarity, particularly in ensuring that key information and celebrations are shared effectively.

A small number of parents (approximately 2 responses) note that aspects of SEND provision, although supportive, can at times lack timeliness or consistency.

There are also isolated concerns (2-3 responses) regarding variability in curriculum implementation, including homework and reading promotion in specific classes, suggesting some inconsistency in practice. A very small number of operational issues, including school meals and changes to wider provision, are also referenced.

We will be using this information as part of our evidence base to inform next year's school development plan and we will share with you how we will respond later in the school year.
