



EQUALITY OBJECTIVES

Objective 1: To monitor and improve outcomes for pupils with SEND

Why: There are some children who have made less progress than others, when compared to starting points and/or compared to age related expectations.

How: We closely monitor progress to identify and support each individual with bespoke intervention and support.

Objective 2: To monitor and improve outcomes for pupils entitled to Pupil Premium Grant

Why: Attainment data evidences that some PPG funded children do not attain as well as their peers across the school.

How: We will identify and support each child with individual and/or group intervention and support. PPG funding is used to offer emotional and well-being support as well as enabling further academic progress.

Objective 3: To provide equality of opportunity for all pupils

Why: To ensure that all pupils are inspired and can set their own aspirations.

How: We will ensure all groups are equally represented in curriculum and resources. E.g. Research and explore girl heroes, female scientists, BME books; sporting opportunities for ALL children.

Objective 4: To enable pupils to understand equality and prejudice

Why: Some pupils do not recognise that their views and actions may be prejudiced.

How: Through assemblies and as part of our ongoing values/PSHE curriculum, we help children to understand how all people are different but equal. We explain what prejudice is, and help children to understand the impact of prejudice.
